

1. TAKE CARE OF ANY UNIFORM PROBLEMS EARLY BEFORE INSPECTION.
2. INSPECTION WILL BE AT TIME GIVEN BY DIRECTOR IN FRONT OF THE SCHOOL. TO PASS INSPECTION YOU MUST:

1. BE ON TIME.WEAR BAND T- SHIRTS UNDER YOUR UNIFORM.
2. UNIFORM MUST BE SPOTLESS & WORN PROPERLY. PANTS & JACKET HEMMED CORRECTLY TO FIT YOU (SLEEVES & PANTS HEMMED)
3. HAVE INSTRUMENT PERFECTLY CLEANED AND IN WORKING ORDER.(REED, MOUTHPIECE, ETC.)
4. HAVE ALL STANDS MUSIC IN PLASTIC FOLDERS.(VICTORS, ARE YOU READY, HEY SONG, LOW RIDER, IRON MAN).
5. FLAG COSTUMING AND MAKE-UP WILL BE DISCUSSED BY MRS. G.
6. ALL HAIR FOR BAND MEMBERS MUST BE PINNED UP OFF YOUR COLLAR THE ENTIRE EVENING, NOT JUST STUCK UP IN YOUR HELMET DURING PERFORMANCE.
7. NO HEAVY MAKE-UP OR DANGLING EARRINGS OF ANY KIND (BEADS ONLY).
8. INSPECTION FAILURES WILL BE POSTED ON EACH MONDAY.
FAILURES MUST RUN 3 LAPS BEFORE OR AFTER EACH PRACTICE THE FOLLOWING WEEK.

3. GLOVES - CLARINET AND OPEN HOLE FLUTES ONLY WILL CUT OUT INSIDE FINGERTIPS. EXTRA GLOVES ARE \$2 A PAIR.

4. NO ONE IS TO LOAD ANYTHING ON ANY BUS UNTIL AFTER INSPECTION, BY CLASSES. YOU MAY SIT WHERE YOU WANT, TRY NOT TO OVERCROWD ANY ONE BUS. **YOU MUST REMAIN ON THE SAME BUS TO & FROM GAMES. THERE WILL BE 7 BUSES.**

5. PERCUSSION INSTRUMENTS WILL BE INSPECTED BY DRUM OFFICERS IN THE BAND ROOM PRIOR TO BAND INSPECTION TIME AND THEN PERCUSSIONISTS WILL ASSIST IN LOADING BEFORE COMING TO THE FRONT OF THE SCHOOL WITH THE BAND. IT IS EACH PERCUSSIONISTS RESPONSIBILITY TO SEE THAT ALL OF THEIR EQUIPMENT IS ACCOUNTED FOR ON THE TRAILER.

6. FLAG/DANCE LINE MEMBERS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR HELPING LOAD THE TRAILER AT THE INSTRUCTIONS OF THE OFFICERS. THERE WILL BE A SCHEDULE OF MEMBERS TO HELP UNLOAD THE TRAILER AFTER EACH PERFORMANCE.

7.AFTER INSPECTION ONLY SOUSAPHONES, TROMBONES, T. SAXES & BARITONES WILL LOAD THEIR INSTRUMENTS ON THE TRAILER. ALL OTHER INSTRUMENTS WILL BE PLACED ON THE BUS. IF YOU PUT AN INSTRUMENT ON THE TRAILER, YOU MUST UNLOAD IT AFTER THE GAME TO IT'S PROPER PLACE IN THE BAND ROOM.

8. ALL STUDENTS MUST RIDE THE BUS TO AND FROM AWAY GAMES (UNLESS SPECIAL PERMISSION IS GRANTED).

9.KEEP UP WITH ALL EQUIPMENT AND UNIFORM PARTS. PROPERLY WEAR UNIFORMS AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN PUBLIC VIEW. GLOVES & HELMETS MAY BE TAKEN OFF IN THE STANDS AND PUT IN TOTE BAG. CARE FOR YOUR UNIFORM AFTER PERFORMANCE & TURN IN PLUMES.

10. GUIDELINES DURING THE GAME:

1. NO DATES OR VISITORS IN THE BAND SECTION.
2. DURING 3RD QUARTER BREAK YOU MAY GO TO THE CONCESSION STAND, REST ROOMS OR THE AREA NEAR THE CONCESSIONS. YOU ARE NOT ALLOWED TO ROAM AROUND STADIUM AREA OR SIT IN OTHER AREAS OF THE STANDS. EVERYONE MUST BE BACK IN THEIR SEATS PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF 3RD QUARTER.
3. STAY IN ASSIGNED SEAT AT ALL TIMES THROUGHOUT THE GAME, READY TO PLAY AND SEATED ON THE STADIUM CUSHIONS.
4. DO NOT LEAVE THE BAND AREA WITHOUT PERMISSION (REST ROOMS). CONCESSION STAND IS OFF LIMITS UNTIL 3RD QUARTER.
5. PROPER BEHAVIOR AND LANGUAGE IS EXPECTED AT ALL TIMES IN THE STANDS. DO NOT THROW ANT ITEMS WHILE IN STANDS. (ICE,ETC.)
6. BUS BEHAVIOR SHOULD BE EXEMPLARY. STAY SEATED, NO LOUD NOISES OR SHOUTING, ETC.
7. NO PECKING ON ANY PERCUSSION INSTRUMENTS. ALL DRUM CHEERS ARE STARTED BY THE DRUM OFFICERS OR DRUM MAJORS ONLY. SWITCHING OF PERCUSSION INSTRUMENTS ON ANY MUSIC IS NOT ALLOWED.
8. ONLY BAND DIRECTOR APPROVED MUSIC IS TO BE PLAYED. DON'T "WING IT".
9. WE WORK VERY HARD AT MAINTAINING A GOOD REPUTATION WITH OUR SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY. PLEASE DO NOT LET BEHAVIOR AT A GAME TARNISH THAT REPUTATION IN ANY WAY. MANY ALUMNI COME BACK JUST TO WATCH THE BAND. YOUR ACTIONS ARE ALWAYS SCRUTINIZED WHILE YOU ARE IN UNIFORM.
